Team Work:

- 1. Freire's student/teacher AND teacher/student; he or she gains two perspectives gains critical consciousness and from this gets a new perspective of the teacher & teaching; this gives the individual a new knowledge and
- 2. Freire's teacher is also student
- 3. Teachers and students learn from each other and are each others' students
- 4. Students learn through experience and conversation and dialogue
- 5. When students receive knowledge, they use that outside of the classroom
- 6. Step one: fix teacher/student relationship—talk amongst themselves, sit in the rear, allow students to make mistakes... thereby creating praxis
- 7. Teaching must be spontaneous—no lesson plan, or minimal one
- 8. Teacher must take advantage of opportunities for student exploration on their own.
- 9. Using Freire's method of learning by using connections would reinforce Percy's concept of learning outside a predictable environment
